If all or any portion of the Order on Rehearing is reversed and the oil pipeline index for the five-year period beginning on July 1, 2021, is increased from the Revised Index, MPL reserves the right to collect from shippers the positive difference between the rates for all barrels shipped from March 1, 2022 forward.
