



## Open Season Notification Magellan Mountain System Potential Refined Products Pipeline Capacity Expansion

### Background

Magellan Pipeline Company, L.P. (“**Magellan**”) is assessing interest in a potential expansion of Magellan’s approximately 450-mile refined products pipeline system from El Dorado, Kansas to Denver (Aurora), Colorado (the “**Mountain System**”) to create additional pipeline capacity. The potential expansion would involve the modification of six (6) existing pump stations, the installation of four (4) drag reducing agent (DRA) sites and tank pump upgrades at Magellan’s El Dorado terminal. As part of this project, Magellan would offer new firm pipeline capacity (“**Reserved Capacity**”) on the Mountain System. The current capacity of the Mountain System is approximately 60,000 barrels per day (“**BPD**”). Once the expansion is complete, the capacity on the Mountain System is expected to increase to approximately 65,000 BPD.



### Open Season Process Overview

Magellan is seeking long term revenue commitments in exchange for the Reserved Capacity through a binding open season process (the “**Open Season**”). Subject to the results of the Open Season and receipt of all necessary permits and approvals, the expanded capacity could be operational by the end of the fourth quarter 2022. Shippers who wish to participate in the Open Season must complete, execute and submit the provided form of Transportation Services Agreement (“**TSA**”) together with any additional information or materials required by Magellan prior to the conclusion of the Open Season. ### **Firm Commitment Program Overview**

Magellan is offering up to a maximum of 4,700 BPD of Reserved Capacity between El Dorado, Kansas and Denver (Aurora), Colorado via a minimum annual revenue commitment. The firm space available is dependent on the product mix a shipper elects to ship in a given month due to the fact that certain products, such as jet fuel, require more capacity than others, such as gasoline. Below are examples of potential product mixes that could be nominated for transportation on the expansion capacity. Actual volumes and product mixes would be scheduled by Magellan in consultation with a firm shipper based on nominations each month.

Magellan is offering three different program levels. The TSA describes the term, total annual revenue commitment, base tariff rate and per product tariff premium associated with each program level.

### **Transportation Services Agreement**

Execution and delivery of the TSA by a shipper constitutes an offer by that shipper to enter into a binding TSA, and that offer will remain open until January 31, 2022. A shipper's offer to ship refined products pursuant to the terms of the TSA shall not be deemed accepted by Magellan, and Magellan shall not be bound by the terms of the TSA, unless the TSA is executed and delivered by Magellan (in its sole discretion).

Once the Open Season period has ended, based on the level of shipper interest, Magellan will make a decision on whether to proceed with the Reserved Capacity program. If Magellan has not executed a TSA submitted during the Open Season by January 31, 2022, each interested shipper will be entitled to terminate its offer.

### **Credit Verification**

When submitting a signed TSA, each shipper must provide evidence of a minimum credit rating as follows:

Magellan may, at its discretion, elect to accept alternative assurances of credit verification provided by a shipper. If a shipper returns an executed TSA and is subsequently unable to satisfy the credit requirements, it will not be eligible to participate in the Open Season.
